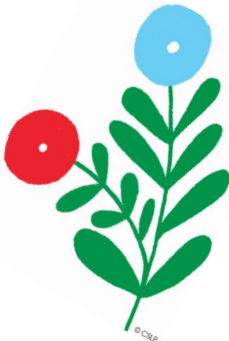
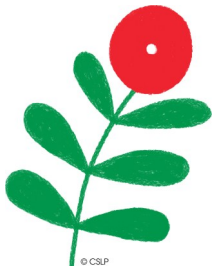
Summer Reading Program May 16–August 9, 2025
